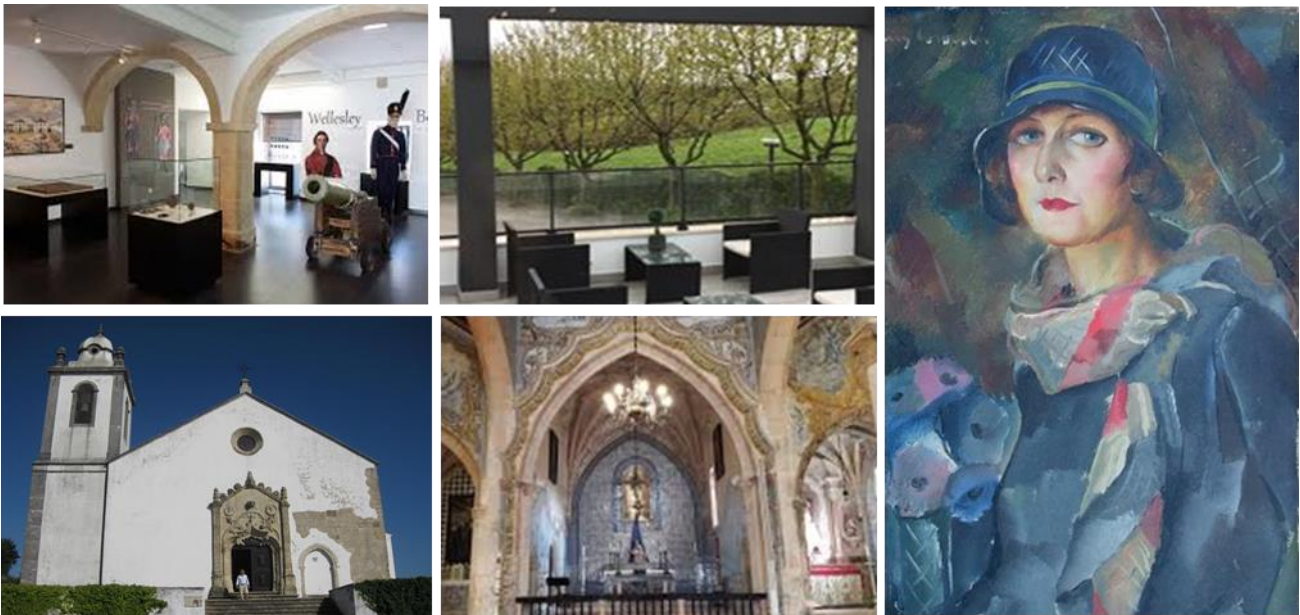
ANNUAL LUNCH
